Objetive

Regenerative Ranching (GANARE, acronym in Spanish) seeks to promote and scale up livestock farming practices with a regenerative approach by strengthening training, technical assistance and financial inclusion models that are consistent with the conservation of natural resources and the social, economic, and cultural well-being of livestock farmers.

Lines of work

- 1 Promotion of financial and technical assistance models that facilitate the transition to sustainable production systems.
- 2 Integration of livestock production properties into the country's conservation and ecological connectivity strategy.



- 3 Capacity building in livestock farming communities to adopt regenerative practices that boost the sector's economic profitability.
