Objective

The project seeks to support the management of priority coastal areas for conservation in northwestern Mexico.

Currently, this fund supports the operation of six private lands located in strategic sites in Baja California, Baja California Sur, Nayarit and Sinaloa.

Supported Areas: 1. San Quintín 2. Pura Prieta, APPF Valle de los Cirios 3. Magdalena Bay 4. El Portezuelo Natural Reserve 5. Santa María Bay 6. Cuyutlán Bay, Marismas Nacionales

Lines of work

- Land monitoring and management, restoration activities, relocation expenses, and personnel costs associated.
- 2 Payment of property and other taxes, and advice on maintaining and documenting land ownership rights.
- Minor infrastructure repairs and replacements, signage, and other similar investments to support the management and protection of natural resources on the land.

Achievements

30,032.72 hectares with some instrument for planning and territorial ordering.

Support for **six** private **coastal lands** for management, monitoring and payment of property taxes.
