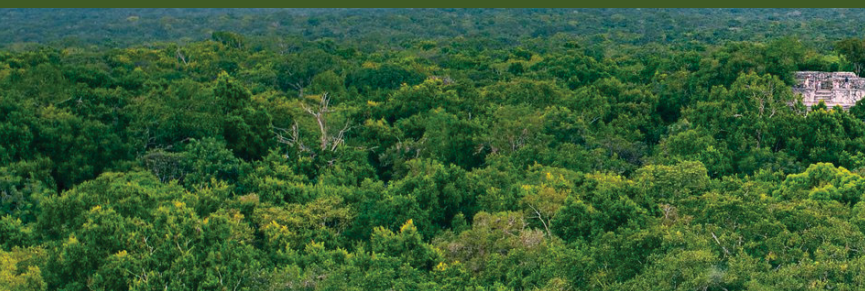
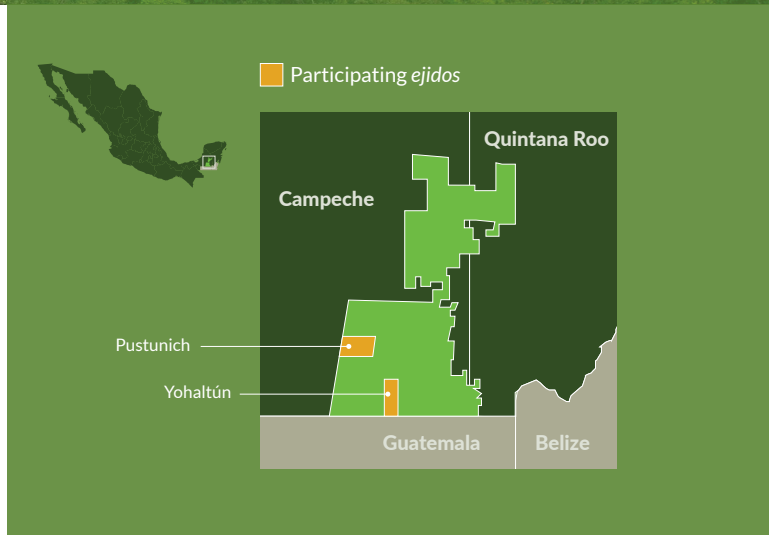

The Calakmul Conservation Fund aims to ensure the maintenance, protection, and enrichment of biodiversity in the Calakmul Biosphere Reserve and its area of influence through payment for ecosystem services (PES) to two communities (*ejidos*) in the region, thus maintaining the connectivity of the jaguar habitat.
