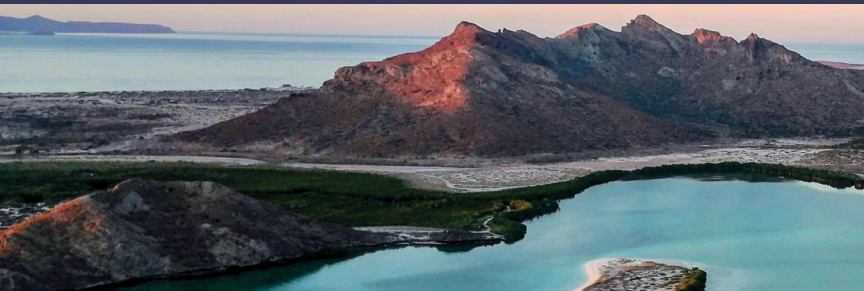

The Gulf of California Fund (FGC, acronym in Spanish) aims to conserve the network of marine-coastal ecosystems representative of the Gulf of California and the North Pacific by channeling resources to initiatives in protected areas and their areas of influence.

- 2 Sustainable initiatives.
- 3 Conservation of habitats and priority species.
- 4 Resilience to climate events.



Achievements

136 initiatives funded to strengthen organizations.

Nine new initiatives will be funded after being selected in the 2024 call.

52 local organizations benefited.
