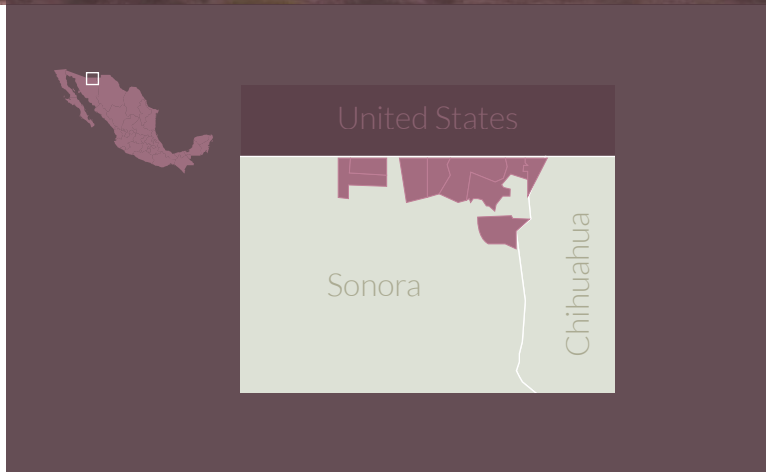
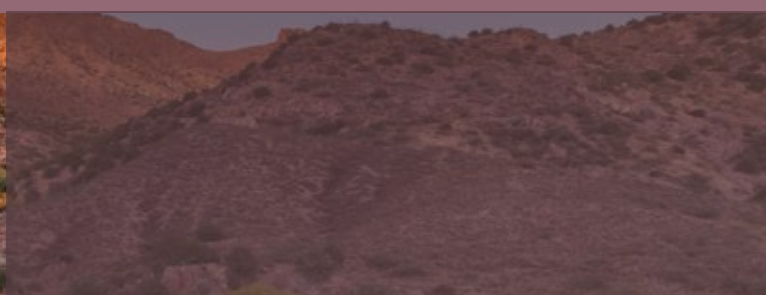

The objective of the project is to ensure the long-term conservation of nine private ranches certified as Areas Voluntarily Designated for Conservation (ADVCS, acronym in Spanish) in northern Sonora, through effective administration and management.
