Objective

The Protected Areas Fund (FANP, acronym in Spanish) is a public-private collaboration between Mexican Fund for the Conservation of Nature (FMCN, acronym in Spanish) and the National Commission of Natural Protected Areas (CONANP, acronym in Spanish). It aims to support the efficient use of financial resources channeled to Mexico's protected areas (PAs), strengthening their operation and management and ensuring the long-term conservation of representative ecosystems.

Lines of work

- 1 Strengthening the National System of Protected Areas.
- 2 Strengthening the operation of 95 priority federal PAs and a complex of Areas Voluntarily Designated for Conservation (ADVCS, acronym in Spanish).
- 3 Immediate attention to extraordinary environmental contingencies in 95 priority federal PAs.

Achievements

FANP contributes to the **conservation** of **8.4%** of the total **terrestrial** area and **9.6%** of the **marine** area.
