Objective

Kaanbal Suut aims to strengthen the capacities, leadership, and networking opportunities of organized groups and civil society organizations in the Yucatan Peninsula that lead socio-environmental projects, to contribute to the scope of their processes and, with it, the advancement of the impacts on the conservation and sustainability of natural resources in the region.

Lines of work

- 1** Theoretical-practical training and group consulting for civil society organizations and organized groups that lead socio-environmental projects in the Yucatan Peninsula.
- 2** Strengthening organized groups and civil society organizations in the Yucatan Peninsula that work with and/or are led by groups of women, youth and/or indigenous peoples.
- 3** Facilitation of virtual networking spaces for civil society organizations and organized groups that have participated in the courses and belong to the Kaanbal Suut network, to trigger knowledge exchanges and the creation of collaborations.
