Objective

Leadership in the Mesoamerican Reef System (L-SAM) aims to accelerate conservation impacts in the Mesoamerican Reef System (MAR) ecoregion, made up of Mexico, Belize, Honduras, and Guatemala. To achieve this, it promotes the development of capacities and the strengthening of the talent of agents who lead and implement high-impact projects in the region.

Lines of work

- 1 Recruiting talent and launching generations annually with leaders from the four countries.
- 2 Development of technical and soft capacities.

- 3 Specialized support in the design and implementation of high-impact projects.
- 4 Creating a network of leaders exchanging knowledge and collaborating on common goals.

Achievements

More than **65** conservation projects incubated.

139 leaders with developed skills.

67 leaders have advanced to positions of greater responsibility, and **25** have influenced public policies.
